MPD (1) 1. Greaves - Barbarossa Paddy Power, Dark Brindle a very raw youngster of just 6 months needs time to develop, good chin, adequate front for his age, enjoyed his day, nice temperament.

P.D. (2) 1. Parker & Martin - Olleyville Optimistic Lad, stunning dark brindle boy caught my eye immediately, has it all at this stage at just under 12 months I'm sure he will go far, good outline, masculine head with good proportions, broad muzzle, good strong neck flowing onto good shoulders, lovely dark eye & expression, good bone, forechest developing nicely, good front & nice tight feet with well arched toes, spot on tail set, good angulation, good muscle developing, moved with power, true both coming & going, shown in tip top condition and very well handled, delighted to award him BEST PUPPY DOG, BEST DOG and later my BEST IN SHOW well done. 2. Pynegar & Loadsby – Berwynfa Fifty Shades Freed, Dark brindle of 11 months, tall & leggy at this stage, good length of neck, nice kind eye, plenty of time to develop, shown in nice condition.

N.D. 1) 1. Littlewood & Bowler – Olleyville James Dean at Whirlbox, Nice masculine brindle boy of 21 months, good bone, clean head, good forearm, good padded muzzle & evident chin, good tail set, nice tight feet, evident forechest, moved well.

P.G. (1) 1. Loasby- Sashbob Le Sorcerer – 2 1/2 year brindle, lovely front, nice head, dark eye with good pigmentation, good mouth & lip placement, good length of neck with elegant arch down to shoulders, good lay of shoulder, good bone & tight feet, coat in nice condition, a little light at the rear at the moment, moved well. Pleased to award him Reserve best dog.

L.D. (6, 1) 1. Littlewood & Bowler – Olleyville Stanley Man at Whirlbox, Mature 3 year old Brindle masculine lad who stood out in this class, handled superbly by his breeder today getting the very best out of him, good clean head, nice eye with alert expression, good mouth & lip placement, good spring of rib & front angulation, well up on his toes today, nice movement away & back, held a good topline. 2. Walker's – Berwynfa Toy Story, medium sized lovely compact rich red 3 year old, super profile when stood, nice head proportions, super lay of shoulder, good angulation, shown in lovely condition but movement was a bit erratic today. 3. McVay – Olleyville Mr Magoo at Lochsunart.

M.P.B. (2) 1. Lowery's – Danlow Tutti Fruiti, Lovely compact Red youngster of just 6 months, still very raw, nice in profile, good shape eye, good lip placement at this stage, good tail set, moved as you would expect at this age. 2. Greaves – Barbarossa Pixie Dust, litter sister of minor puppy dog, again same comments, Dark Brindle a very raw youngster of just 6 months needs time to develop, good chin, adequate front for her age.

P.B. (3) 1. McVay's – Daervlish Love Rescue Me at Lochsunart, a lot to like about this 10 month old stylish Brindle youngster, pleasing head, lovely neck flowing onto good shoulders, nice dark eye of good shape, kind expression, good lip placement and dentition, square in profile, good temperament, moved well, nice tuck up, shown in lovely condition. 2. Lowery's – Gollybox Magix

and Mayhem at Danlow, another 10 month brindle youngster, at the leggy stage. 3. Brenard's – Milton Red Ruthie.

J.B. (1) Foster's – Boxsanuk Aanya, 16 month old flashy red, difficult to assess today as very unsettled, broad deep chest, nice clean coat, moved ok.

N.B. (3, 1) Two stylish girls in this class, 1. Fay-Smith's – Winuwuk Paige Three at Lorrosa, this 2 year old dark brindle had a lovely outline, good bone & muscle tone, lovely dark eye & expression, pleasing head, lip placement & dentition, good feet, moved soundly. 2. Tarbett & Coxon's – Frankolina Domino Vitali, Judged this lovely 2 year old dark brindle before, she has the same attributes as 1. Unfortunately she lost out on movement today.

P.G.B. (5,1) Picken's – Bellebox Top Trick, 2 year old dark brindle, square in profile, nice head proportions, nice length of neck, good forechest, good bone & shoulder placement, excellent angulation, spot on tail set, moved true. 2. Lowery's – Danlow Chance Ya Luck, dark brindle 3 year old, longer in body than 1, nice in profile, nice head qualities, good bone, shown in lovely condition. 3. Brunton's – Newlaithe Dream on Daltamie, 4. Foster's – Fun-Nook Von Aisneren at Boxsanuk.

L.B. (2,1) Fay-Smith's – Lorrosa Scouts Honor, nice square outline, feminine head of good proportions, nice crested neck, good lip placement, shown in lovely condition, moved well.

O.B. (3,2) Fay-Smith – Lorrosa Shine Like a Diamond, what a eye catching 18 month dark brindle bitch, just loved everything about her, super square profile, beautiful feminine head, good lip placement & dentition, nice dark eye & expression, good angulation & feet, good bone, and shoulder placement, good spring of rib, splitting hairs over this young lady and my best dog, 2 super exhibits, awarded her BEST BITCH & RESERVE BEST IN SHOW, well done.

V.B (1) Picken's – Petarris Top Issue for Bellebox, what a lovely feminine girl who did not look her 9 years, nice head proportions, good ear set, nice padded muzzle, lovely expression, up on her toes today, shown & moved in lovely condition, pleased to award her BEST VETERAN IN SHOW, well done.
